

Cybersecurity Statement

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Subject: Defense Federal Acquisition Regulation Supplement Section 252.204-7012

As cybersecurity attacks continue to increase in frequency and sophistication it is imperative that we all do our part in securing the Aerospace and Defense supply chain and protecting sensitive information and intellectual property.

In response to these threats the Department of Defense added a new clause to the Defense Federal Acquisition Regulation Supplement (DFARS). This clause, "Safeguarding Covered Defense Information and Cyber Incident Reporting" (Section 252.204-7012), requires all DoD prime contractors and subcontractors to implement "adequate security" based on a set of security controls referenced in NIST SP 800-171 (Protecting Controlled Unclassified Information in Nonfederal Systems and Organizations) and to conduct cyber incident analysis and reporting.
